## DAY 1 - ARRIVAL TO LEVI

Meet & greet by our English speaking guides at the airport, transfer to Levi – your hotel is brand new Sokos Levi.

Pre-registered check-in – keys ready in envelopes on a hospitality desk, luggage is carried to rooms by hotel porters

In the evening dinner is served in hotel's restaurant, 3-courses w/coffee

## DAY 2 - OLYMPICS - THERE IS NO GAMES LIKE SNOW GAMES!

Breakfast buffet at hotel

10:00 meet your guides at hotel lobby – Transfer to Winter Fun stadium where there are rinks and stations for each event, and campfires for enjoying a refreshing juice or a hot coffee.

Upon arrival at the Stadium the first ceremony is to light the Olympic fire and take the Olympic oath. The group is divided into smaller teams which rotate from station to station during the snow whirling fun of the winter games. The teams compete against each other by collecting points in various events for example:





- Kick sleigh relay
- Reindeer lassoing
- Snowshoe relay
- Quattro-ski relay
- Quattro kick-sleigh relay
- Moby kick-sleigh relay
- Smartness test

The fun continues at the Ice Karting track with your own private Grand Prix with IceKarts. IceKart is an, exciting, and truly fun go-cart race on ice. There is a training period and a final race just like in the Formula races. Skill and composure are the key here. ICEKART is THE experience! Outdoor lunch is served around one of the campfires. During the victory ceremony the best team will be awarded a prize according to Lappish customs.

Duration of Olympic Games and Ice Karting programme including lunch and transfers is approximately 4 – 4½ hrs

In the evening, transfer to restaurant Tuikku – A fully-licensed panoramic restaurant on top of the Levi fell. The restaurant offers some of the best views in Levi and you may even catch a glimpse of the Northern Lights. The restaurant seats up to 180 persons. Transfers to/from Tuikku by private coach

## DAY 3 - SNOWMOBILE SAFARI TO THE WILDERNESS

Breakfast buffet at hotel

Meet your guides after breakfast at hotel lobby for yet another day in the wilderness.

Short walk to the snowmobile park where after driving instructions and safety rules off you drive – 1 person per snowmobile – through the beautiful fell area of Levi.

The route takes you through snow-covered forests and driving on frozen lakes and rivers to a wilderness camp where hot soup with bread and butter is offered as lunch followed by campfire coffee and sweet bun.



Return back to Levi by snowmobiles. Duration 4 hours.

In the evening transfer by coaches to private dinner venue – Luvattumaa – where the farewell gala dinner is organized.

### **Dinner sample – feast of gnomes:**

*Winter vegetable soup seasoned with smoked reindeer and served with unleavened bread*

*Variety of fish delicacies served with a vegetable wok*

*Sautéed reindeer, mashed potatoes, lingonberry sauce and pickled cucumbers*

*Pancakes with jam and coffee or tea*



This menu is served from the open fire situated in the middle of the restaurant.

Transfer back to Levi after dinner – continue the evening in the many discos and bars of the Levi resort.



## DAY 4 - FAREWELLS TO LAPLAND!

Breakfast buffet at hotel

Luggage handling and transfer to the airport, farewells to your guides!



## Program Inclusions:

- 3 nights' occupancy and breakfast in Sokos Hotel Levi, twin basis.
- Luggage handling in hotel in/out.
- Day 01: Transfer by private coach from KTT airport to Sokos Hotel Levi
- Day 01: 3-course halfboard dinner w/coffee at hotel restaurant
- Day 02: Olympic Games and Ice karting, 2-course soup lunch, duration 4-4,5 hrs
- Day 02: 6-courses w/coffee dinner restaurant Tuikku, transfers by private coach
- Day 03: Snowmobile safari to wilderness, 2 persons on snowmobile, duration 4 hours
- Day 03: 3-courses w/coffee dinner at Luvattu Maa, transfers by private coach
- Day 04: Transfer by private coach to KTT airport.
- Safari outfits at guests' disposal during the programs: thermal overalls, boots, woollen socks, leather mittens, balaclavas, scarves and caps as well as helmets for snowmobiling
- Local guiding in English during the programs and dinners
- All service fees and Value Added Tax (VAT)

## Good to note:

---

All programs are with weather permittance. All the items are subject to availability at the time you request the space. We reserve the right to change the rates in the event of increase of taxes, fuel costs or similar beyond our control.

### INSURANCE

All the snowmobiles and forest scooters are insured, as required by the Finnish Traffic Insurance Act. This insurance covers medical care for injuries to the driver and the passenger arising from accidents. Personal injuries and damages to other parties while driving a snowmobile or forest scooter are fully covered according to the Finnish Traffic Insurance Act. Lapland Safaris is not liable in general for personal injuries or material damage arising from accidents during other games and activities such as, dog or reindeer-sled safaris or other excursions in which snowmobiles are not involved. Personal travel insurance is therefore highly recommended.



## SELF LIABILITY

Safari participants are held liable for damages caused to snowmobiles or forest scooters. Each vehicle driver must put down a damage deposit on the spot upon their arrival, by cash or credit card, if other arrangements have not been made in advance. The amount of the deposit is EUR 505,- for snowmobiles and forest scooters. The customer must notify Lapland Safaris in advance about who (each participant individually or the orderer /company) is going to be held responsible for self liability. The self liability is mentioned during the snowmobile driving lesson before safari.

## DRIVING TERMS

The driver of a snowmobile must be 15 years old with a valid driving licence, forest scooter driver has to be at least 18 years old with a valid driving license. Children under 2 years old are free of charge and children under 15 years old get a discount and they are then allowed to sit on a sledge pulled by a snowmobile. Children under 15 years old are seated in a sledge pulled by snowmobile and are given helmets.

Driving a snowmobile or forest scooter under the influence of alcohol or any narcotic products is prohibited by Finnish law. As the responsible safari organizers, we reserve the right to change the routing and duration of the excursions if necessary, according to the prevailing weather and snow conditions, or if deemed advisable for the sake of safety and the comfort of the participants. We also reserve the right to discontinue the safari if a participant is seen as a potential danger to him/herself or to others, or is in poor health.

## MEALS & BEVERAGES

All lunches in the program include 2 courses, bread & spread, and as beverages water, berry juice and coffee/tea. All dinners in the program include 3 courses (unless otherwise stated, bread & spread, and as beverages water and coffee/tea.
